

## Fish Stocking Update



The stocking of Mitchell Lake began the Spring of 2019. MLA provided the initial \$1,000 in funding, and the rest has come from voluntary donations.

Since that time over 3,200 game fish have been planted in regular Spring and Fall deposits—often coinciding with the Spring shoreline clean-up. An additional 1,050 fingerling walleye were planted in the Fall of 2019, and the rest have been adult fish. For survivability adult largemouth bass up to 16", walleye up to 22", and black crappie up to 11" have been regularly contributed to the lake. Hopefully natural spawning will take over in all species.

Given the size of Mitchell Lake, I think we have done an outstanding job of restoring our lake to fishing. The fish program is now in a maintenance phase in which stocking will be scheduled as needed with the designated funds that are available.

### **GOOSE MANAGEMENT**



Are geese a nuisance in your part of the lake? To have geese removed from your property, file a goose complaint with the City of Eden Prairie. Go to **EdenPrairie.org** and search for "goose management" or scan the QR below.

Goose complaints must be filed by individual homeowners, and the time to file is between May 15th and the 30th.



### Mitchell Lake Weed Harvesting Rebate

The City of Eden Prairie has confirmed that it will contract a weed harvesting company again this July. MLA offers a \$100 rebate to its members for private shoreline harvesting and will work with the city to get notifications out to those on our email list. ### MITCHELL LAKE 2023 WATER QUALITY REPORT





### Down with Buckthorn—Volunteers Needed!

Have you noticed the large swaths of buckthorn along the shores of Mitchell Lake? Buckthorn is an unwelcome and invasive plant that can negatively impact water quality.

Buckthorn outcompetes the native groundcover plants needed to stabilize soil and prevent runoff. MLA is partnering with the City of Eden Prairie and the Friends of Eden Prairie Parks to hold buckthorn removal events in Miller Park this fall. Volunteers will learn how to identify buckthorn and effectively remove it. Area restoration activities may also be included. Details will be available later this summer.
